Joshua Lawrence Chamberlain (18281914) earned national fame following the Battle of Gettysburg for his key role in fending off the Confederates at Little Round Top on day two of the battle, inspiring a central character in two feature films (Gettysburg and Gods & Generals) and a Pulitzer Prizewinning novel (The Killer Angels), and featuring prominently in Ken Burns's The Civil War. Chamberlain went on to be a Medal of Honor recipient, governor of Maine, and president of Bowdoin College, and his Civil War memoirs are among the most quoted. Here Thomas Desjardin, the former archivist at Gettysburg National Military Park and a historical advisor to both films, turns to the personal side of Chamberlain through a collection of 300 letters spanning his life, from his formative years and his courtship with Fanny Adams through his career as a Union commander and the aftermath of the war.
