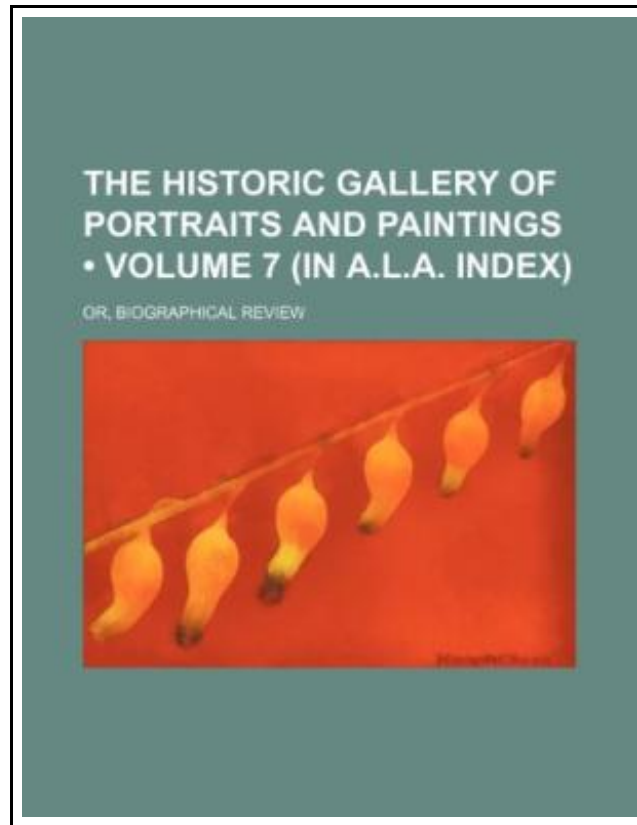

It was in vain that the constable Montmorency opposed their marriage with all his influence. The important of her kingdom to Prannp, and the power of her uncles, the Princes of Lorraine, were more than sufficient to counteract his intrigues, and the Dauphin obtained the most beautiful princess in Christendom. Though this alliance placed the Queen of Scotland in the most conspicuous point of view, it may be considered as having accidentally laid the foundation of the greatest part of her future misfortunes.
