In an era when trade guilds in France largely excluded women as members in their own right, the images depicted in Denis Diderot's *Encyclopédie* and other contemporary French sources reveal what the statutes and archives of the time obscure: that women played integral, essential, and varied roles in the worlds of craft, manufacture, and commerce.
